AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to commercial driver education training; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 805, which relates to license fees; modifying terms; modifying fee; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 805, is amended to read as follows:

Section 805. All licenses, purchased or renewed after the effective date of this act, shall ~~expire on the last day of the calendar year~~ be valid for a four-year term and may be renewed upon application to the Commissioner as prescribed by his or her regulation. Each application for an original or renewal school license shall be accompanied by a fee of ~~Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)~~ One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each application for an original or renewal instructor's license shall be accompanied by a fee of ~~Five Dollars (\$5.00)~~ Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). The license fees collected pursuant to Sections 801 through 808 of this title shall be remitted to the State Treasurer to be credited to the

1 General Revenue Fund in the State Treasury. No license fee shall be
2 refunded in the event that the license is rejected, suspended, or
3 revoked.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
