12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

15	As used in this act, an "international mobile subscriber
16	identity catcher (IMSI-catcher)" or "Stingray" is a mobile device
17	that captures the signaling information, which may include, but not
18	be limited to, the phone number and serial number of electronic
19	communication devices within the vicinity. The IMSI-catcher mimics
20	a cell site tower in that it reads signaling information broadcast
21	
22	in public by electronic communication devices turned on in the area
23	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 178.2 of Title 13, unless there
24 27	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A law enforcement agency is prohibited from using an
 international mobile subscriber identity catcher (IMSI-catcher) or
 Stingray to obtain an individual's real-time or historical
 electronic communication device location information without first
 obtaining a search warrant pursuant to Sections 1221 through 1241 of
 Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

B. Nothing in this act shall prohibit the Oklahoma Department
of Corrections from using an IMSI-catcher or Stingray.

9 C. Any data collected while using an IMSI-catcher or Stingray, 10 as a result of a warrant authorizing such usage, that is captured 11 not as the target of the warrant shall be inadmissible in a court of 12 law and any applicable data must be destroyed in an unrecoverable 13 manner within twenty-four (24) hours of capture.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. B
