SENATE BILL 625

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial bridge designations; designating the "William Charles "Charley" Coen Memorial Highway"; requiring certain markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the western municipal limits of the town of Buffalo in Harper County, extending to N1860 Road, shall be designated as the "William Charles "Charley" Coen Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
