SENATE BILL 764

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act; authorizing advertising and sale of raw graded and ungraded milk direct to consumers; requiring labeling; requiring records be kept; authorizing inspections of sales records by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-422 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. Notwithstanding any rule or provision of law to the contrary, the holder of a permit for distribution of Grade A milk pursuant to Section 7-406 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act or the distribution of ungraded milk by permit as provided in Section 7-417 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act may advertise and sell raw graded and ungraded milk directly to

consumers within this state from the onsite operation. The product shall be labeled as raw milk and the grade of milk, if graded.

- Notwithstanding any rule or the provisions of Sections 7-406 and 7-417 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act prohibiting distribution of Grade A raw milk or ungraded raw milk without a permit, persons operating a farm with a milk producing cow or cows may advertise and sell their raw milk onsite directly to consumers without a permit, provided the product is labeled "Ungraded and unpermitted raw milk".
- Each seller of raw milk under this section shall be required С. to keep records of their direct consumer sales each month. Sales records of raw milk distributed directly to consumers may be inspected by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry as the official state agency under the authority of the United States Department of Agriculture for purposes of enforcing dairy inspections, milk grading programs and the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
