6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Department of Labor; directing
8 the Commissioner of Labor to conduct certain analysis
9 for certain purpose; requiring list of items that
10 create efficiencies; requiring completion of analysis
11 by certain date; providing a report; directing
distribution of report; providing for
noncodification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 The Commissioner of Labor is directed to analyze, evaluate and
17 develop a timeline and plan for the Department of Labor of items
18 that will strengthen, automate and modernize the internal
19 administration and operations and external services and contacts
20 with the public. As part of the analysis and evaluation of the
21 Department, the Commissioner shall create a list of areas and/or
22 items according to their priority and cost to the Department that
23 will create more measurable efficiencies, better services and
24 increased cost savings for the state. A written report of the

1 analysis and evaluation shall be completed by January 15, 2022. A
2 copy of the report shall be distributed to the President Pro Tempore
3 of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
4 Governor.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
