6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Solicitation of
8 Charitable Contributions Act; prohibiting imposition
9 of certain filing or reporting requirements;
10 clarifying applicability of provisions; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 552.23 of Title 18, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Except as required or authorized by federal law, no state
17 agency or official shall impose any annual filing or reporting
18 requirement on an organization regulated or specifically exempted
19 from regulation under the Oklahoma Solicitation of Charitable
20 Contributions Act that is more stringent, restrictive or expansive
21 than the requirements authorized by the laws of this state.

22 B. The requirements of subsection A of this section shall only
23 apply to nonprofit organizations that are organized as private
24 foundations or charitable trusts; provided, nonprofit hospitals

1 shall be exempt from the provisions of this section. The
2 requirements of subsection A of this section shall not apply to
3 state grants, state contracts or fraud investigations, and shall not
4 restrict enforcement actions against specific nonprofit
5 organizations.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
