SENATE CONCURRENT  
RESOLUTION 17

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution modifying deadlines for third reading of certain measures in the chamber of origin and chamber opposite chamber of origin; and amending joint rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of subsection (c) of Joint Rule 7 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, as set forth in Enrolled House Concurrent Resolution No. 1001 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the legislative procedure schedule is amended to read as follows:

RULE SEVEN

LEGISLATIVE SCHEDULE

(a) The First Regular Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

1        1. January 21, 2021, no later than 4:00 p.m., shall be the  
2 deadline for introduction of bills and joint resolutions in the  
3 Senate and House of Representatives for consideration on the floor  
4 of the House of Representatives or Senate during the First Regular  
5 Session.

6        2. March 11, 2021, shall be the final legislative day for Third  
7 Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the  
8 chamber of origin.

9        3. April 22, 2021, shall be the final legislative day for Third  
10 Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the  
11 chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

12       4. The First Regular Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature  
13 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 28, 2021.

14       5. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both  
15 chambers, a bill or joint resolution may be exempted from all  
16 deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt  
17 rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

18       (b) The Second Regular Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature  
19 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

20       1. December 10, 2021, shall be the final date for requesting  
21 the drafting of bills and joint resolutions in the House of  
22 Representatives and Senate for introduction for consideration during  
23 the Second Regular Session.  
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1        2. January 20, 2022, no later than 4:00 p.m., shall be the  
2 deadline for introduction of bills and joint resolutions in the  
3 Senate and House of Representatives for consideration on the floor  
4 of the House of Representatives or Senate during the Second Regular  
5 Session.

6        3. The Second Regular Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature  
7 shall convene at twelve noon on February 7, 2022.

8        4. ~~March 17, 2022~~ March 24, 2022, shall be the final  
9 legislative day for Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or  
10 joint resolution in the chamber of origin.

11       5. ~~April 28, 2022~~ May 5, 2022, shall be the final legislative  
12 day for Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint  
13 resolution in the chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

14       6. The Second Regular Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature  
15 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 27, 2022.

16       7. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both  
17 chambers, a bill or joint resolution can be exempted from all  
18 deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt  
19 rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

20       (c) This schedule may be amended or modified by the adoption of  
21 a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the membership of each  
22 chamber.

23       (d) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any joint resolution  
24 introduced for the purpose of disapproving or approving agency rules

1 pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, or  
2 for the purpose of disapproving or approving standards adopted by  
3 the State Board of Education as set forth in Section 11-103.6a-1 of  
4 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 (e) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bills introduced  
6 for the purposes of incorporating and merging different versions of  
7 a statute amended in more than one measure at the same or different  
8 sessions of the Legislature as set forth in Section 23.1 of Title 75  
9 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 (f) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
11 resolution introduced for the purpose of approving, disapproving,  
12 repealing or modifying rules of the Ethics Commission pursuant to  
13 the provisions of Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma  
14 Constitution.

15 (g) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
16 resolution which proposes a special or local law and for which  
17 notice of intended introduction is published in a newspaper for four  
18 consecutive weeks pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of  
19 Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.

20 (h) The dates specified in this Rule for introduction of bills  
21 or joint resolutions shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
22 resolution which contains an "RB" number pursuant to the provisions  
23 of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act. Such  
24 measures shall be submitted to the legislative actuary not later

1 than such dates, and may be introduced not later than the first  
2 Monday in February following such submission.

3 (i) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
4 resolution authored by the chairs and vice-chairs of the Senate  
5 Appropriations Committee and the House Appropriations and Budget  
6 Committee which affects the receipt, expenditure or budgeting of  
7 state funds or funds under the control of an entity created by state  
8 law.

9 (j) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
10 resolution authored by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and  
11 the Speaker of the House of Representatives which is deemed by them  
12 to be necessary for the preservation of public peace, health or  
13 safety.

14 (k) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint  
15 resolution authored by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and  
16 the Speaker of the House of Representatives which provides for  
17 redistricting.

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
