AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution condemning the Biden administration's proposal to give the World Health Organization the power to regulate United States public health policy.

WHEREAS, the Constitution requires the United States Senate to ratify all treaties; and

WHEREAS, the presidency has no authority to enter into such agreements or policies to circumvent the Constitutional requirement to ratify treaties; and

WHEREAS, reports suggest the current administration is intending to give up American and Oklahoman sovereignty to foreign and international organizations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

1            THAT the Legislature condemns the Biden administration's  
2 proposal to give the World Health Organization the power to regulate  
3 United States public health policy.

4            THAT any policy or agreement not properly ratified as a treaty  
5 that would make America or the State of Oklahoma subservient to any  
6 foreign entity including but not limited to the World Health  
7 Organization, shall be null, void and of no effect in the state.

8            THAT each member of the executive branch including the Governor,  
9 Attorney General, county sheriffs, and all members of law  
10 enforcement shall oppose any such policy or agreement by any means  
11 necessary to uphold the Constitution.
