The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 17 the following proposed amendment to Section 30 of Article II of the 18 Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows: 19 Section 30. The right of the people to be secure in their 20 persons, houses, electronic data and electronic communications, 21 papers, and effects against unreasonable searches or seizures shall 22 not be violated; and no warrant shall issue but upon probable cause 23 supported by oath or affirmation, describing as particularly as may

be the place to be searched and the person or thing to be seized.

6	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
7	This measure amends Section 30 of Article 2 of the Oklahoma
8	Constitution. This section protects the rights of the people
9	against unreasonable searches and seizures. This measure would
10	add electronic data and communications to the list of items that
11	require a warrant based on probable cause to search for or seize
12	such items.

16	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
