AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution reaffirming Oklahoma's support of  
Israel.

WHEREAS, Israel declared its independence and self-governance on  
May 14, 1948, with the goal of establishing a proud and sovereign  
homeland for the Jewish people; and

WHEREAS, as the first country to recognize Israel as an  
independent state and as Israel's principal ally, the United States  
has enjoyed a close and mutually beneficial relationship with Israel  
and her people; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma and Israel have enjoyed cordial  
and mutually beneficial relations since 1948, a friendship that  
continues to strengthen with each passing year; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma supports the continual endeavors  
for cooperative and mutual assistance between our nation and Israel;  
and

1           WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma condemns all acts of terrorism  
2 and denounces those who would use violence against innocent men,  
3 women and children; and

4           WHEREAS, attacks from the terrorist organization known as Hamas,  
5 have resulted in the deaths of innocent men, women and children.

6           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION  
7 OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8           THAT the Oklahoma State Senate stands resolutely with Israel and  
9 supports the Israeli government to defend its people and country  
10 against all attacks.
