Cullison; 8 mourning his loss; and directing distribution. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, Robert V. Cullison was born in Turley, Oklahoma, on 12 December 22, 1936, to Georgia Lucille and O.G. "Cotton" Cullison. 13 In 1963, he married Francie Cranford of Skiatook and they had two 14 children: a daughter, Robin, and a son, Robert; and 15 WHEREAS, Bob never forgot his roots, and always considered 16 himself to be a "Turley Boy." He attended Baylor University on a 17 baseball scholarship as a proud member of the Baylor Bears, 18 graduating with a degree in Business Administration. He was a 19 patriot, serving his country in the United States Marine Corp 20 Reserves, and as a businessman; and 21 WHEREAS, Bob Cullison was elected to the Oklahoma House of 22 Representatives in 1972, serving there until his election to the 23 Senate District 34 seat in 1978. In 1988, he became President Pro

Tempore of the Senate, serving for three terms before leaving the

Legislature in 1994. Among his legislative accomplishments were passage of House Bill 1017, a landmark education funding and reform bill; the Quality Jobs Act, aimed at diversifying Oklahoma's economy; and authoring legislation for necessary statutory changes accompanying passage of the 1984 state question legalizing liquor-by-the-drink; and

WHEREAS, after leaving the Legislature, Bob became a member of the Oklahoma Tax Commission and later served as Governmental Affairs Director of the Oklahoma Bankers Association; and

WHEREAS, Bob loved the give and take of the legislative process and loved the Senate. He was known for his intelligence, humor and tenacity and was respected and admired by members on both sides of the aisle; and

WHEREAS, Senate President Pro Tempore Bob Cullison passed from this life on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, at the age of 84.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the life and service of Senate President Pro Tempore Bob Cullison and hails his contributions to this state.
