Since 1996, Oklahoma exports to 16 Israel have totaled more than \$882 million, ranking Israel as 17 Oklahoma's 17th leading trade partner; and 18 WHEREAS, in 1992, Governor David Walters created the Oklahoma-19 Israel Exchange, which became an official non-profit organization 20 during the administration of Governor Frank Keating. In 2003, 21 Governor Brad Henry led a delegation that included senior government 22 officials, Jewish community leaders, and businesspeople from 23 throughout Oklahoma on a mission geared towards expanding Israel-

WHEREAS, in 2011, U.S. Senator James Inhofe led a group of more than 10 U.S. legislators from six different states on a tour, which included Israel, where they met with American and Israeli security officials to discuss collaborative efforts at combatting terrorism and other threats; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, legislation was passed by the Legislature and signed by Governor Kevin Stitt declaring that Israel is a prominent trading partner of the State of Oklahoma and that the state, and those companies that do business by and through the state, in the interest of the state's economic policy, should not boycott trade with Israel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate reaffirms Oklahoma's strong, historical alliance with Israel and continues to support mutually beneficial business, cultural, and governmental relationships.
