AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges;
designating the Capt. David Arthur Peters Memorial
Highway; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 9 beginning at the intersection of
Interstate 35 then extending west to the intersection of U.S.
Highway 62, in McClain County shall be designated as the "Capt.
David Arthur Peters Memorial Highway". The Department of
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
