15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1301 of Title 18, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. Any private, nonprofit or for-profit organization which
20	receives public funds from the state and provides philanthropic or
21	humanitarian services to adults and children from developing
22	countries or who are living in developing countries shall obtain
23	consent for videography and photography before recording or
24	

1 photographing images of children and adults from or in developing 2 countries. The consent shall:

1. Be written in a language that the subject of the videography 3 4 or photography prefers or is most proficient in. If the subject is 5 illiterate, verbal consent in the preferred language of the subject may be given and recorded on video. If the subject is a child under 6 7 eighteen (18) years of age, consent shall be obtained from the parent, guardian or person responsible for the child. If the child 8 9 is without adult supervision or care, action should be taken by the 10 organization to address the physical safety and medical needs of the 11 child prior to recording or photographing images of the child;

12 2. Be revocable at any time;

13 3. Be specific and explain how the recorded or visual images14 will be used and disseminated;

4. State how the images will be stored and accessed, including
storage in a safe and regulated environment with controlled access;

18 5. Not be required as a condition for receiving or obtaining
19 services or assistance from the organization.

B. In addition to the requirements listed in subsection A ofthis section, children and adults shall not:

Be coerced or forced to participate in being recorded or
 photographed;

1 2. Be recorded, photographed or otherwise pictorially 2 represented if they are unclothed and if their torso or any private 3 parts are exposed; and 3. Be recorded, photographed or otherwise pictorially 4 5 represented if they are in a dangerous situation or their health or 6 physical safety is in jeopardy. 7 C. As used in this section: 1. "Developing countries" means countries that are economically 8 9 and socially disadvantaged; 10 "Humanitarian" means concerned with or seeking to promote 2. 11 human welfare; and 12 3. "Philanthropic" means seeking to promote the welfare of 13 others, especially by donating money or goods to charitable causes. 14 SECTION 2.
