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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 956, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 956. A. No operator, employee, or contractor of a
18	wrecker or towing service or of a person or business that derives
19	any business or income from a wrecker or towing service shall offer,
20	and no officer or employee of the Corporation Commission, Department
21	of Public Safety or any political subdivision of the state shall
22	accept, directly or indirectly, any compensation, gift, loan, favor
23	or service given for the purpose of influencing the officer or
24	employee in the discharge of official duties of the person.

1 B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, no 2 officer of the Commission, Department or any law enforcement officer of any political subdivision of the state shall have any interest, 3 4 financial or otherwise, in a wrecker or towing service, or with a 5 person or in a business that derives business or income from a wrecker or towing service, nor shall a wrecker or towing service or 6 7 a person or business that derives any business or income from a wrecker or towing service employ such officer. 8

9 C. <u>1.</u> An officer of the Commission, Department or a law 10 enforcement officer of any political subdivision may have an 11 interest, financial or otherwise, in or may be employed by a wrecker 12 or towing service when the sole purpose and only business of the 13 wrecker or towing service is to perform repossessions of vehicles 14 which are subject to lien and are being repossessed by the lien 15 holder of record.

16 2. A law enforcement officer of any political subdivision may 17 have an interest, financial or otherwise, in or may be employed by a 18 wrecker or towing service; provided that, the wrecker or towing 19 service the officer is affiliated with is not in the same county in 20 which he or she is employed as a law enforcement officer. 21 SECTION 2.
