6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1750.11, which relates  
9 to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private  
Investigator Act; making certain acts unlawful;  
providing penalties; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1750.11, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1750.11 A. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, any  
16 person convicted of violating any provision of the Oklahoma Security  
17 Guard and Private Investigator Act or a rule or regulation  
18 promulgated pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private  
19 Investigator Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by  
20 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than sixty (60) days,  
21 or by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or  
22 by both such imprisonment and fine.

23 B. Any person who willfully makes a false statement, knowing  
24 such statement is false, in any application to the Council on Law

1 Enforcement Education and Training for a license pursuant to the  
2 Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act, or who  
3 otherwise commits a fraud in connection with such application,  
4 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a term  
5 of imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for  
6 not less than two (2) years nor more than five (5) years, or by a  
7 fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or by both  
8 such imprisonment and fine.

9 C. Any person who:

10 1. Impersonates a licensed security guard or licensed armed  
11 security guard with the intent to induce another to submit to the  
12 pretended authority of the person or to rely on the person's  
13 pretended acts of a licensed security guard or licensed armed  
14 security guard; or

15 2. Knowingly purports to exercise any function that requires  
16 licensure as a security guard or armed security guard,  
17 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by  
18 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or  
19 by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or by  
20 both such imprisonment and fine.
