6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2011, Section 15-113, which relates to penalties for
9 parking in a disabled parking place; excluding
10 certain penalties for a person with a Purple Heart
11 recipient license plate; modifying penalty for
12 certain offense; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 15-113, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 15-113. A. Any person who knowingly makes or procures
17 the making of a false statement in an application submitted pursuant
18 to Sections 15-111 through 15-113 of this title is guilty of a
19 misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five
20 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each falsified statement. This
21 penalty shall be stated on all applications.

22 B. 1. Any person who has not been issued a physically disabled
23 parking placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this
24 title, a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the

1 provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, a disabled veterans
2 license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this
3 title, a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to the
4 provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, a disability sticker
5 issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs and federal military
6 bases, or a physically disabled placard or license plate issued by
7 another state, and uses a placard, sticker, or license plate to park
8 in a disabled parking place is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
9 conviction shall be punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars
10 (\$500.00). A person transporting a physically disabled person with
11 an authorized placard, sticker or license plate, as provided in
12 subsection A of Section 11-1007 of this title, shall be excluded
13 from the provisions of this section.

14 2. Any person who has been issued a physically disabled parking
15 placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title,
16 a physically disabled license plate issued pursuant to the
17 provisions of Section 1135.1 of this title, ~~or~~ a disabled veterans
18 license plate pursuant to the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this
19 title or a Purple Heart recipient license plate issued pursuant to
20 the provisions of Section 1135.2 of this title, and knowingly allows
21 the placard or license plate to be used by a person not issued the
22 placard or license plate as described in paragraph 1 of this
23 subsection, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
24 punished by a fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

1 C. A person who knowingly makes a counterfeit physically
2 disabled parking placard or physically disabled license plate is
3 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a
4 fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each counterfeit placard
5 or license plate made by such person.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
