7 An Act relating to insurance; prohibiting insurers  
8 from making certain policy benefit changes without a  
9 policyholder's written agreement; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6057.6 of Title 36, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any insurer issuing health benefit plans in this state shall not  
17 make material changes to a policy benefit, including the removal of  
18 a patient's provider from his or her network contract, at any time  
19 during which the policy is in force, except in the case of medical  
20 malpractice, billing and collections practices in violation of the  
21 provider agreement, or a violation of ethical standards as set forth  
22 by statute or by the provider's licensing body, without the express  
23 written agreement of the policyholder.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
