HOUSE BILL 2375

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to license plate fees; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1116, which relates to registration periods; modifying registration period for certain vehicles; requiring fees for certain plates to be remitted in same registration period; requiring the promulgation of rules; maintaining certain apportionment; amending 47 O.S. 2011, Sections 1135.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2016, 1135.2, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019, 1135.3, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019, 1135.4, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018, 1135.5 as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019, 1135.6, and 1135.7, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020, Sections 1135.1, 1135.2, 1135.3, 1135.4, 1135.5, and 1135.7), which relate to special or personalized license plates; requiring certain single registration period; requiring promulgation of rules; construing provision with respect to apportionment; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1116, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1116. A. Twelve registration periods shall be established for vehicles required to be registered on a staggered

1 basis. The registration periods shall start on the first day of
2 each calendar month and shall end on the last day of that month.
3 Unless otherwise provided, all such vehicles where the date of
4 execution of transfer of ownership occurs in this state at any time
5 during a calendar month shall be subject to registration and payment
6 of the fee for the registration period commencing the first day of
7 the month of such date of execution of transfer.

8 B. 1. A person who registers more than one vehicle may have
9 all of such vehicles initially registered at the same time or at
10 separate times. Any person who obtains a vehicle may, upon
11 registration, have the registration period adjusted to allow future
12 registration of all such vehicles at the same period or at a
13 different period.

14 2. Any two or more noncommercial vehicles owned by the same
15 person and previously registered in this state may be registered at
16 the same time regardless of the month or months in which the
17 vehicles were previously registered. The month in which the
18 noncommercial vehicles are newly registered shall be the month in
19 which the registration is renewed annually. If a noncommercial
20 vehicle is registered pursuant to this subsection in the same
21 calendar year in which it was previously registered, license and
22 registration fees shall be prorated to account for the difference
23 between the previous renewal month and the new renewal month and
24

1 those fees shall be due at the time of registration pursuant to this
2 subsection.

3 C. If a special or personalized license plate is issued
4 pursuant to Sections 1135.1 through 1135.7 of this title, any
5 registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
6 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
7 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
8 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
9 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
10 special or personalized license plate is obtained during a twelve-
11 month period for which a registration fee has already been remitted
12 pursuant to this subsection. The combination of fees in a single
13 remittance shall not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for
14 by law.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.1, as
16 amended by Section 1, Chapter 26, O.S.L. 2016 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
17 Section 1135.1), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1135.1 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
20 plates to persons as provided by this section.

21 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
22 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
23 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
24

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Except as provided in subsection B of this section, special
4 license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax Commission or a
5 motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall annually notify by
6 mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall
7 contain all necessary information and shall contain instructions for
8 the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or
9 the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a
10 staggered system. The motor license agent fees shall be paid out of
11 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

12 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section,
13 any registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
14 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
15 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
16 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
17 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
18 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
19 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
20 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
21 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

22 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
23 follows:
24

1 1. Political Subdivision Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 for any vehicle owned by any political subdivision of this state
3 having obtained a proper Oklahoma certificate of title. Such
4 political subdivisions shall file an annual report with the Tax
5 Commission stating the agency where such vehicle is located. Such
6 license plates shall be permanent in nature and designed in such a
7 manner as to remain with the vehicle for the duration of the life
8 span of the vehicle or until the title is transferred to an owner
9 who is not a political subdivision.

10 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
11 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
12 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

13 2. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed for:

- 15 a. any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and
16 power unit owned and operated by a religious
17 corporation or society of this state holding a valid
18 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section
19 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C.,
20 Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization
21 in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as
22 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and that is
23 used by the corporation or society solely for the
24 furtherance of its religious functions,

- 1 b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit
2 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
3 including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy
4 Scouts of America,
- 5 c. any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or
6 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved
7 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and
8 used exclusively in the transportation of goods or
9 materials for such organization,
- 10 d. any vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit
11 organization that provides older persons
12 transportation to and from medical, dental and
13 religious services and relief from business and social
14 isolation,
- 15 e. any vehicle owned and operated by a private nonprofit
16 organization that:
- 17 (1) warehouses and distributes surplus foods to other
18 nonprofit agencies and organizations, and
- 19 (2) holds a valid exemption from taxation issued
20 pursuant to Section 501(c) of the Internal
21 Revenue Code, as amended, 26 U.S.C., Section
22 501(c), and listed as an exempt organization in
23 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
24 as amended, and

- 1 (3) uses such vehicle exclusively for the
2 transportation of such surplus foods,
- 3 f. any vehicle which:
- 4 (1) is owned and operated by a private, nonprofit
5 organization which is exempt from taxation
6 pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3)
7 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
8 501(c)(3), and which is primarily funded by a
9 fraternal or civic service organization with at
10 least one hundred local chapters or clubs, and
- 11 (2) is designed and used to provide mobile health
12 screening services to the general public at no
13 cost to the recipient, and for which no
14 reimbursement of any kind is received from any
15 health insurance provider, health maintenance
16 organization or governmental program, or
- 17 g. any vehicle owned and operated by the Civil Air
18 Patrol, a congressionally chartered corporation that
19 also serves an auxiliary of the United States Air
20 Force and which is exempt from taxation pursuant to
21 the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
22 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and is
23 used exclusively for its corporate missions of
24 aerospace education, cadet programs and emergency

1 services. Such license plates shall be permanent in
2 nature and designed in such a manner as to remain with
3 the vehicle for the duration of the life span of the
4 vehicle or until the title to such vehicle is
5 transferred to an owner who is not subject to this
6 exemption. Such vehicles shall be exempt from the
7 registration fees levied under Section 1132 of this
8 title, except that an initial registration fee of
9 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) shall apply to each
10 vehicle.

11 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit
12 license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the
13 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently
14 displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles
15 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this
16 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law
17 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-
18 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each
19 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two
20 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit
21 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization
22 which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily
23 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet
24 while the vehicle is not in motion.

1 Except as provided in subparagraph g of this paragraph, the
2 registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in
3 addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the
4 registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

5 3. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for persons who are eligible for a physically disabled
7 placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. It
8 shall prominently display the international accessibility symbol,
9 which is a stylized human figure in a wheelchair. The Tax
10 Commission shall also design physically disabled license plates for
11 motorcycles owned by persons who are eligible for a physically
12 disabled placard pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-112 of
13 this title. Upon the death of the physically disabled person, the
14 disabled license plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission.
15 There shall be no fee for such plate in addition to the rate
16 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act for
17 the registration of the vehicle. For an additional fee of Ten
18 Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for a physically disabled
19 license plate shall have the option of purchasing a duplicate
20 physically disabled special license plate which shall be securely
21 attached to the front of the vehicle. The original physically
22 disabled special license plate shall be securely attached to the
23 rear of the vehicle at all times.

1 Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license
2 plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the
3 physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the
4 second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the
5 vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee
6 shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the
7 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

8 4. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be designed
9 for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal Association
10 exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-473 and used
11 by the tribal association exclusively for the furtherance of its
12 tribal functions.

13 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
14 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
15 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

16 5. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may
18 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a
19 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment
20 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and
21 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice
22 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. The
24 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily

1 identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional
2 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the
3 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply;

4 6. Antique or Classic Vehicles License Plates - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued for any vehicle twenty-five (25) years
6 of age or older, based upon the date of manufacture thereof and
7 which travels on the highways of this state primarily incidental to
8 historical or exhibition purposes only.

9 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
10 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
11 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Any
12 person registering an antique or classic vehicle may elect to have
13 the vehicle registered for a ten-year period. The registration fee
14 for the elected ten-year registration shall be Seventy-five Dollars
15 (\$75.00). The motor license agent registering the antique or
16 classic vehicle for a ten-year period shall receive one hundred
17 percent (100%) of the fees the motor license agent would have
18 otherwise received pursuant to subsection A of Section 1141.1 of
19 this title if the antique or classic vehicle had been registered on
20 an annual basis; and

21 7. Honorary Consul License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to include the words "Honorary Consul" and issued to
23 persons who are honorary consuls authorized by the United States to
24 perform consular duties. Persons applying for such license plates

1 must show proof of standing as an honorary consul. The fee for such
2 plate shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all
3 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act. The owner of the vehicle that possesses such
5 license plates shall return the special license plates to the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission if the owner disposes of the vehicle during
7 the registration year or ceases to be authorized to perform consular
8 duties.

9 C. Special license plates provided by this section shall be
10 designed in such a manner as to identify the use or ownership of the
11 vehicle. Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate
12 provided by this section for any purpose not specified herein shall
13 be grounds for revocation of the special license plate and
14 registration certificate.

15 D. The fees provided by this section shall be deposited in the
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

17 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
18 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
19 2020, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
21 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
22 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
23 provided by this section.
24

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
13 amateur radio operator license plates.

14 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section,
15 any registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
16 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
17 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
18 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
19 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
20 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
21 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
22 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
23 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.
24

1 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
2 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
3 applications for special license plates authorized under this
4 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
5 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
6 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
7 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
8 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
9 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
10 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
11 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
12 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
17 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
18 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
19 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
20 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
21 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
22 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
23 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
24 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war

1 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
4 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

6 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
8 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
9 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
10 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

11 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
13 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
14 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
15 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

16 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
18 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
19 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
20 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
21 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
22 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
23 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
24 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services

1 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form
2 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
3 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
4 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

5 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
6 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
7 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
8 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
9 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

10 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

11 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
13 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
14 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
15 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
16 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
17 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
18 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
19 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
20 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
21 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
22 of one (1) ton or less;

23 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper

1 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
2 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
3 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
4 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
5 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
6 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
7 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
8 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
9 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
10 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
11 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
12 provided by this section for special license plates;

13 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
15 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
16 the United States as being:

- 17 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
18 7, 1941,
- 19 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
20 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
21 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
22 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 23 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
24 States Armed Forces.

1 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
2 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
3 less;

4 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
6 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
7 States as being:

- 8 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
9 of 1945,
- 10 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
11 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
15 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

16 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
17 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
18 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
19 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
20 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
21 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
22 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
23 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
24 registration after the initial issue;

1 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
3 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
4 the United States as being:

5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
6 1944,

7 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
8 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
9 participation cannot be verified by the United States
10 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
11 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
12 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
13 the person applying for the license plate, and

14 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
15 States Armed Forces.

16 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
17 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
20 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
21 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
22 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
23 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
24 was killed in action and that the person making the application is

1 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
2 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
3 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
4 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
5 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
6 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
7 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
10 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
11 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
12 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
13 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
14 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
15 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
22 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
23 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
24 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a

1 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
6 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
7 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
10 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
11 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
12 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
13 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
14 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
16 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
17 education police department by either an identification card or
18 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
19 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
20 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
21 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
22 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
24 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design

1 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
2 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

3 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
5 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
6 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
7 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
8 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
9 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may
10 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
11 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

12 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
13 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
14 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
15 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
16 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
17 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
18 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
19 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
20 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
21 "WORLD WAR II";

22 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
2 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
3 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
4 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
5 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
11 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
12 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
13 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
14 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
15 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

16 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
18 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
19 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
20 be produced upon application;

21 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
23 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
24 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a

1 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
2 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
3 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
4 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
5 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
6 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
7 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
8 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
9 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
10 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

11 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
12 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
13 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
14 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
15 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
16 of one (1) ton or less;

17 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
19 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
20 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
21 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
23 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
24

1 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
2 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

3 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
5 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
6 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
7 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
8 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

9 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
11 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
12 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
13 the Ninety-Nines;

14 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
16 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
17 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
18 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
19 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
20 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
21 less;

22 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
24 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United

1 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
2 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

4 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
6 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
7 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
8 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

9 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
10 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
11 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
12 United States Secretary of Defense;

13 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
16 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
17 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
18 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
21 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
22 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
23 district number;

31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees

1 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
2 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

3 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
4 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
5 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
6 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
7 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
8 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
9 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
10 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
11 the Tax Commission;

12 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
14 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
15 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
16 designed in consultation with the Association;

17 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
19 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
20 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
21 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
23 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
24 Academy;

1 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
3 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
4 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
5 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
6 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
7 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
8 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
9 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
10 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
11 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
12 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
13 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
14 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
15 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
16 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
17 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
18 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
19 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
20 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
21 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
22 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
23 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
24 right to such special identification plates herein provided for

1 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
2 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

3 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
5 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
7 Oklahoma;

8 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
10 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
11 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
12 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
13 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
14 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
15 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
16 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
17 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
18 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
19 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
20 state;

21 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
23 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
24 shall mean:

- 1 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
2 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
3 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
4 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
5 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
6 while on active military duty, or
- 7 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
8 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
9 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
10 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
11 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
12 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
13 discharge of such person.

14 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
15 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
16 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
17 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

18 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
20 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
21 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
22 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
3 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
4 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
5 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
6 Infantry;

7 40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
8 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
9 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
10 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
11 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
13 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
14 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
15 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

16 41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
18 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
19 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
20 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
21 (1) ton or less;

22 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
24 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in

1 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
2 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
3 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
4 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
5 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
6 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of
7 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
8 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
9 license plate;

10 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
11 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
12 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
13 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
14 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
15 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
16 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
17 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
21 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
22 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
23 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
24 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.

1 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
2 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
3 (1) ton or less;

4 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
6 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
7 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
8 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
9 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
10 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
11 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

13 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
14 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
15 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
16 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
17 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

19 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
20 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
21 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
22 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
23 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
24 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

1 48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
3 who present proper certification from the United States Department
4 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
5 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
6 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

8 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
10 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
11 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
12 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
13 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
14 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
15 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

16 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
17 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
18 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
19 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
20 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
21 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
22 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
23 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

1 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who
3 present proper certification from the United States Army. The
4 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the
5 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge
6 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying
7 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
8 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
9 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
10 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

11 52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
13 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi
14 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license
15 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
16 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for
17 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
18 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
19 for a motorcycle license plate;

20 53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
22 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation
23 Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat
24 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
2 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
3 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
4 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

5 54. Special Forces Association License Plates - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
7 member of the Army Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear
8 upon the person's United States military uniform the Army Special
9 Forces Tab. Persons applying for the Special Forces Association
10 license plate must provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special
11 Forces Tab or authorizing its wear upon a United States military
12 uniform. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
13 the Special Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. The Tax Commission
14 shall produce up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces
15 Association license plate. Qualified persons may select one design
16 at the time of application. The plates shall be issued to any
17 qualified person in any combination of numbers and letters from one
18 to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.

19 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
20 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
22 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
23 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
24 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

1 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
2 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2020, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
7 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
8 subject as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
13 registered for the current year.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
15 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
16 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
17 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
18 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
19 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
20 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
21 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

22 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section,
23 any registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
24 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be

1 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
2 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
3 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
4 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
5 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
6 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
7 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
21 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
22 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
23 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
24 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
2 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
3 removed from the vehicle.

4 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
5 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall
6 be developed or issued by the Tax Commission until the Commission
7 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
8 prepaid applications must be received by the Tax Commission within
9 one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the
10 authorization or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In
11 the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by
12 the Tax Commission within such prescribed time period any payment so
13 received shall be refunded accordingly.

14 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
15 follows:

16 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 round and square dancing;

19 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
20 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
21 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
22 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

23 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
24 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle Association;

4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall contain the Masonic emblem;

5. 1 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
3 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
4 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
5 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
6 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
7 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
8 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
10 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

11 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
13 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
14 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
15 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
16 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
17 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
18 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
20 Columbus emblem;

21 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
22 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
23 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
24 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

1 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
3 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
4 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with Kiwanis International;

6 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
8 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
9 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
10 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
11 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
12 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
13 Accountants;

14 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
16 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
17 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
18 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
19 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
20 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
21 emergency management department head;

22 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and

1 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
2 Conservation Corps;

3 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
4 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
5 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
6 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
7 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
8 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
9 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
11 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

12 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
13 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
14 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
15 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
16 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

17 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
20 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
21 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
22 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

23 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,

1 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
2 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
3 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
4 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
5 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
6 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
7 personalized license plates;

8 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
10 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
11 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
12 consultation with American Business Clubs;

13 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
15 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
16 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
17 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
18 Oklahoma;

19 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

23 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
24 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

1 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

3 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
5 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
6 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

7 23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
9 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
10 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
11 for personalized license plates;

12 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
14 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
15 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

16 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
18 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
19 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
20 Association;

21 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
23 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
24

1 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
2 Sorority;

3 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
4 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
5 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
6 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
7 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
8 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
9 Incorporated;

10 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
12 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
13 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
14 of Health;

15 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
17 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
18 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
19 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

20 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
21 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons

14 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
15 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

16 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
19 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
20 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

21 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

1 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
3 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

4 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
6 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
7 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
8 Weather Center Directors;

9 42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish

15 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to

10 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
11 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
12 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters

15 48. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
19 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
20 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
21 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

22 49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
2 School Alumni Association;

3 50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
6 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
7 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
8 Association;

9 51. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
13 Association;

14 52. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

7 55. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem
9 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
10 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

12 56. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
14 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
15 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
16 Arts;

17 57. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
21 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
22 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

23 58. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

8 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

4 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
5 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

6 65. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
9 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
10 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall
11 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
12 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject
13 to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
14 Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective
15 November 1, 2015;

16 66. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
19 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

20 67. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
21 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
22 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
23 representatives of the Frederick School District;

1 68. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
3 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
4 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
5 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

6 69. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
8 Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the
9 Oklahoma Fosters Initiative;

10 70. Red Dirt Jeeps License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
12 Red Dirt Jeeps and such plates shall be designed in consultation
13 with Red Dirt Jeeps, L.L.C.;

14 71. Sons of the American Revolution License Plate - such plates
15 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
16 Sons of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle in any
17 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
18 as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in
19 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Sons of the American
20 Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar
21 design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
22 requirements of a motorcycle license plate;

23 72. Daughters of the American Revolution License Plate - such
24 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for

1 the Daughters of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle
2 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
3 seven, as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Daughters of the
5 American Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of
6 similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the
7 space requirements of a motorcycle license plate;

8 73. Air Medal License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
9 issued to Air Medal recipients. An individual requesting the plate
10 is required, at the time of application, to show proof he or she is
11 a recipient of the Air Medal or sign an attestation stating that he
12 or she is a medal recipient. The plates shall be designed to
13 include the Air Medal emblem and shall include the words "Air Medal"
14 on the plate;

15 74. Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy License Plate - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy.
18 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
19 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
20 personalized license plates. The plates shall contain the official
21 Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy logo;

22 75. The Pride of Oklahoma Marching Band License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for the Pride of Oklahoma marching band. The

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the University of
2 Oklahoma;

3 76. The Spirit of Oklahoma State Marching Band License Plate -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Spirit of Oklahoma State marching band.
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahoma State
7 University;

8 77. Southeast Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 Southeast High School Spartans and such plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association;

12 78. Catoosa High School License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 Catoosa High School located in Catoosa. The plates shall bear the
15 image of the Catoosa High School mascot and be designed in
16 consultation with representatives of Catoosa High School;

17 79. Toastmasters International License Plate - such plates
18 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
19 Toastmasters International and shall be designed in consultation
20 with District 16 of Toastmasters International;

21 80. Millwood High School Alumni License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for Millwood High School Alumni. The license plate shall be
24

1 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood High
2 School Alumni Association;

3 81. Patriot Guard Riders License Plate - such plates shall be
4 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for Patriot Guard
5 Riders and shall be designed in consultation with the Patriot Guard
6 Riders of Oklahoma; and

7 82. Bixby School District License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the Bixby School District. The license plate shall be designed in
10 consultation with representatives of the Bixby School District.

11 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
12 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
13 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
14 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
15 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
16 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
18 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
19 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
20 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104 of this title.

22 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, as
23 amended by Section 3, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
24 Section 1135.4), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.4 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue personalized license plates. The
3 personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
4 except for vintage decals.

5 Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to
6 any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer
7 of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate
8 may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other
9 vehicle has been registered for the current year.

10 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year
11 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by
12 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1)
13 year. The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued
14 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
15 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
16 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
17 The motor license agent fees for renewals shall be paid out of the
18 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

19 If a personalized license plate is issued pursuant to this
20 section, any registration fee required for such plate and the fee
21 required pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall
22 be remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
23 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
24 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a

personalized license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period
for which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to
this subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance
shall not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

B. Such plates shall be designed and issued for the following:

1. Any person in any combination of numbers or letters from one to a maximum of seven;

2. Persons eligible for two or more of the military decoration special license plates provided for in this title. Such plates may be issued in any combination of emblems. However, such plates shall only display up to three emblems and shall also display any combination of letters or numbers from one to a maximum of three;

3. Motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters from one to a maximum of six;

4. Persons eligible for Korean War Veteran license plates provided for in this title. Such plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three on each side of the insignia or emblem;

5. Persons eligible for World War II Veteran license plates provided for in this title. Such plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three on each side of the insignia or emblem; and

6. Persons owning vehicles which are twenty-one (21) years and older are qualified to submit for approval by the Tax Commission or

1 a motor license agent a vintage but expired official Oklahoma
2 license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and older. Upon
3 approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be issued the
4 annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or agent shall
5 direct to be affixed.

6 C. The fee for such plates shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per
7 year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration
8 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
9 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the personalized tag
10 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
11 Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle
12 License and Registration Act. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per year of
13 renewal of the personalized tag fee shall be apportioned as provided
14 in Section 1104 of this title.

15 SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
16 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 434, O.S.L. 2019 (47 O.S. Supp.
17 2020, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
20 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
21 financial assistance as provided by this section.

22 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
4 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
5 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

6 The Tax Commission shall notify by mail all persons issued special
7 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
8 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
9 presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission. The
10 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

11 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section,
12 any registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
13 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
14 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
15 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
16 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
17 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
18 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
19 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
20 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

21 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
22 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
23 applications for special license plates authorized under this
24 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's

1 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
2 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
3 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
4 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
5 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
6 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
7 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

9 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
10 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
11 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
12 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
13 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
14 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
15 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
16 removed from the vehicle.

17 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
18 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
19 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
20 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
21 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
22 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
23 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
24

1 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
2 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
6 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

10 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
12 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
14 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
15 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
16 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
20 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
21 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
22 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
23 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
24

1 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
2 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

3 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

5 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
6 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
7 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
8 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.

9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
12 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
13 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
15 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
16 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
17 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

19 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
20 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
21 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
22 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

23 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license plates.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the prevention of child abuse.

As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States

1 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
2 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
3 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
4 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
5 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
6 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
7 issued;

8 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
10 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
12 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

13 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

14 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
15 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
17 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
18 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
19 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
20 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

21 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
24 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66

1 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
2 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
3 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
4 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
5 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
7 issued;

8 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
10 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
11 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
12 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
13 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
14 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
17 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
18 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
20 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
21 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
22 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
24

1 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
7 Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
23 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
24 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

1 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
2 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
3 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
4 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
5 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
6 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
7 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
8 Section 1104.4 of this title;

9 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
11 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
14 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
15 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
16 1104.3 of this title;

17 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
19 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
22 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
23 deposited in the Oklahoma ~~Capitol Complex and Centennial~~
24 ~~Commemoration Commission~~ Department of Commerce Revolving Fund

1 created in Section ~~98-5~~ 5012 of Title ~~73~~ 74 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes;

3 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
5 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
8 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
9 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
10 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
11 follows:

- 12 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
13 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 14 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
15 Education Revolving Fund,
- 16 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
17 Career Technology Fund, and
- 18 d. eighty-five percent (85%) ~~of the fee~~ shall be
19 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
20 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes.

22 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
23 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
24 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be

1 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
2 paragraph;

3 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
4 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
5 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
6 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
7 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
8 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
9 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
10 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
11 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
12 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
13 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
14 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
15 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
16 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
17 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
18 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
20 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

21 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
23 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
24 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to

1 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
2 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
3 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
4 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
5 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
6 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
7 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
8 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

9 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
11 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
13 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
14 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
16 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
17 of this title;

18 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
22 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
24

1 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
2 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

3 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
4 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
5 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
6 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
7 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
8 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
9 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
10 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
12 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
13 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
14 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
15 created families;

16 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
17 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
18 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
19 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
20 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
21 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
22 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
23 this title;

1 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
4 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
6 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
7 Section 1104.7 of this title;

8 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
9 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
10 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
11 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
12 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
14 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
15 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
16 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
17 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
18 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
19 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

20 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
23 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
24 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's

wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.8 of this title;

27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon for any licensing

1 fees which may be required in order to use the Oklahoma City
2 Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
3 provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon of not
4 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

5 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
7 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
8 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
9 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

10 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
11 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
12 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
13 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
14 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
15 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
16 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
17 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

18 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
21 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
24 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet

1 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
3 Section 1104.10 of this title;

4 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
6 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
7 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
8 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
11 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
12 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

13 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
16 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
17 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
18 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
19 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
20 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
21 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
22 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
5 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
10 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be designed
15 in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Association. As
16 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be

11 79. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
13 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
15 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
16 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
17 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
18 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
19 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
20 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
21 issued;

22 80. Navajo School Foundation License Plate - such plates shall
23 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
24 Navajo School Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with the administration of the Navajo School
2 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
3 enter into a licensing agreement with the Navajo School Foundation
4 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
6 for a payment to the Navajo School Foundation of not more than
7 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

8 81. Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. License Plate - such
9 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Music
10 Hall of Fame Inc. and issued to any member of the organization
11 wishing to demonstrate support. The Tax Commission shall be
12 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
13 Music Hall of Fame Inc. for any licensing fees which may be required
14 in order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Music Hall of
16 Fame Inc. of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
17 plate issued. The plates shall incorporate a numbering system
18 agreed upon by the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. and the Tax
19 Commission. Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this
20 section, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame Inc. License Plate is
21 hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2019;

22 82. Techlahoma Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
23 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
24 Techlahoma Foundation. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Techlahoma Foundation. The plate shall be
2 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
3 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. The Tax
4 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
5 with the Techlahoma Foundation for any licensing fees, which may be
6 required in order to use the association's logo or design. The
7 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Techlahoma
8 Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
9 plate issued;

10 83. Bethany Public Schools Foundation License Plate - such
11 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
12 for the Bethany Public Schools Foundation. The license plates shall
13 be designed in consultation with the administration of the Bethany
14 Public Schools Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
15 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Bethany
16 Public Schools Foundation for any licensing fees which may be
17 required in order to use the Foundation's logo or design. The
18 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Bethany
19 Public Schools Foundation of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
20 for each license plate issued;

21 84. Cystic Fibrosis Foundation License Plate - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
23 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
24 consultation with the administration of the Cystic Fibrosis

1 Foundation. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
2 enter into a licensing agreement with the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation
3 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
4 Foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
5 for a payment to the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation of not more than
6 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 85. Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
8 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for the Down Syndrome Association of Central
10 Oklahoma. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with the
11 Association. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited in the Down Syndrome Association of
13 Central Oklahoma License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section
14 1104.30 of this title;

15 86. Elk City Education Foundation License Plate - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the Elk City Education Foundation. Such plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Foundation. As provided in this
19 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
20 Elk City Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created
21 in Section 1104.31 of this title;

22 87. A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma (ABATE)
23 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
24 person wishing to provide financial support for ABATE of Oklahoma.

1 Such plates shall be designed in consultation with ABATE of
2 Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
3 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
4 as for personalized plates. The license plate for a motorcycle may
5 be of similar design as space permits or a new design in order to
6 meet the space requirements of a motorcycle license plate. The
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
8 licensing agreement with ABATE of Oklahoma for any licensing fees
9 which may be required in order to use the ABATE of Oklahoma logo or
10 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 ABATE of Oklahoma of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
12 license plate issued;

13 88. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed for a vehicle or motorcycle in any combination of
15 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
16 personalized plates, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable
18 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
19 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
20 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
21 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
22 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
23 official logo or design of the organization. The license plate for
24 a motorcycle may be of similar design as space permits or a new

1 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
2 license plate. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a
3 licensing agreement with the Downed Bikers Association for any
4 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall
6 provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers Association of not more
7 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate;

8 89. Eagle Scout License Plate - Such plates shall be designed
9 to demonstrate support for Eagle Scouts and shall include the Eagle
10 Scout logo. Plates may be issued to any person who can show proof
11 of having obtained the rank of Eagle Scout. The Oklahoma Tax
12 Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement
13 with the various Oklahoma local councils for any licensing fees
14 which may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design.
15 The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than
16 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued to the
17 specific Oklahoma local area Council designated by the applicant;

18 90. Extraordinary Educators License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any person wishing to provide financial
20 support for common education in Oklahoma. Such plates shall be
21 designed in consultation with the State Department of Education.
22 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
23 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
24 personalized plates. As provided in this section, an amount of the

1 fee collected shall be deposited in the Extraordinary Educators
2 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.32 of this
3 title;

4 91. Former Oklahoma Legislator License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person who previously served as
6 a member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or Oklahoma State
7 Senate. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
8 the Oklahoma Historical Society. As provided in this section, an
9 amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
10 Historical Society Capital Improvement and Operations Revolving Fund
11 created in Section 1.10a of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The
12 Tax Commission shall create and maintain a list of former members of
13 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
14 eligible to be issued such plates; provided, that no former member
15 of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma State Senate
16 shall be eligible to possess more than two of such plates at any one
17 time. The Tax Commission shall confer as needed with the Chief
18 Clerk of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Secretary of
19 the Oklahoma State Senate to confirm that such list is complete and
20 accurate;

21 92. Monarch Butterfly License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 the operations of the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma. Such plates
24 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the

1 Nature Conservancy. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
2 into a licensing agreement with the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma
3 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
4 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
5 for a payment to the Nature Conservancy of Oklahoma of not more than
6 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

7 93. Oklahoma Tennis Foundation License Plate - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support for the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation. The license plates
10 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Tennis
11 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
12 licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation for any
13 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
14 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
15 for a payment to the Oklahoma Tennis Foundation of not more than
16 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

17 94. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
19 for the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation. The license plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars
21 Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation for
23 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
24 foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Veterans of Foreign Wars Foundation of not more
2 than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 95. Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any female veteran of any
5 branch of the United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate
6 support for the Oklahoma Women Veterans Organization. The license
7 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Women
8 Veterans Organization. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
9 enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Women Veterans
10 Organization for any licensing fees which may be required in order
11 to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing agreement
12 shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma Women Veterans
13 Organization of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
14 license plate issued;

15 96. FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and
16 Technology) License Plate - such plates shall be issued to any
17 person wishing to demonstrate support for FIRST Robotics Programs.
18 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
19 administration of FIRST. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
20 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with FIRST for any
21 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the FIRST logo
22 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 FIRST of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
24 plate issued;

1 97. Pittsburg State University License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Pittsburg State University. The license plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with Pittsburg State University.
5 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
6 agreement with Pittsburg State University for any licensing fees
7 which may be required in order to use the school foundation's logo
8 or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
9 the Pittsburg State University of not more than Twenty Dollars
10 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

11 98. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
12 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
13 Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival held in the Historic
14 Greenwood District in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued
15 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
16 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
17 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Black Wall Street
18 Chamber of Commerce. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee
19 collected shall be deposited in the Historic Greenwood
20 District/Juneteenth Festival Revolving Fund established in Section ~~5~~
21 2368.32 of ~~this act~~ Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Two Dollars
22 (\$2.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Public School
23 Classroom Support Revolving Fund, for expenditure as provided in
24 Section 1-123 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
2 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
3 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

5 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
6 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
7 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
8 authorizing the special license plate;

9 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
10 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
11 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
12 Registration Act; and

13 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
14 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

15 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.6, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1135.6 The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby authorized
18 to design and issue National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing
19 Driver ("NASCAR") Theme License Plates. Such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
21 NASCAR auto racing. The plates shall be of such design as the
22 supplier of the license plates in consultation with the Oklahoma Tax
23 Commission may prescribe. The fee for such plate shall be Forty
24 Dollars (\$40.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration

1 fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
2 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section, any
3 registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
4 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
5 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
6 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
7 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
8 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
9 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
10 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
11 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

12 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
13 agreement with the supplier of such NASCAR Driver license plates or
14 other entity for any required licensing fees. The licensing
15 agreement shall provide for a payment of not more than Twenty-five
16 Percent (25%) of the fee authorized for each license plate issued.
17 Five Dollars (\$5.00) of the forty-dollar fee shall be apportioned to
18 the General Revenue Fund. The remaining amount of such fee shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 For license plates numbered zero (0) through one hundred (100)
21 displaying a particular NASCAR Driver theme, the Oklahoma Tax
22 Commission may establish an auction or similar procedure for the
23 purpose of determining the order in which such distinctive license
24 plates are sold and the amount of the additional fee for the

1 distinctive license plates. This amount shall be due at the time
2 the original application is submitted to the Tax Commission and
3 Forty Dollars (\$40.00) thereafter annually at the time of renewal
4 registration.

5 SECTION 8. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, as
6 amended by Section 5, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2018 (47 O.S. Supp. 2020,
7 Section 1135.7), is amended to read as follows:

8 Section 1135.7 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission or private
9 vendor with whom the Commission has contracted is authorized to
10 design and issue special license plates to any person that applies
11 to the Tax Commission or private vendor for the creation of a
12 special license plate and meets the minimum standards and
13 qualifications specified in this section.

14 B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the
15 Tax Commission shall authorize the issuance of a special license
16 plate to the person making application for the special license
17 plate:

18 1. The license plate is to:

19 a. show membership in or affiliation with an
20 organization, or

21 b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or
22 cause;

23 2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product,
24 brand, or service that is provided for sale;

1 3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on
2 prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and

3 4. Two hundred prepaid applications for the special license
4 plate are received by the Tax Commission or private vendor.

5 C. The fee for special license plates shall be determined in
6 accordance with Section 1 of this act. If the special license plate
7 does not provide financial assistance the fee shall be no less than
8 Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year of renewal and shall be in
9 addition to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma
10 Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in
11 this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall be
12 apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special
13 license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission
14 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma
15 Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining amounts of
16 the special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
17 Section 1104 of this title.

18 D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial
19 assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section 1 of this
20 act. Provided, the fee shall be no less than Thirty-five Dollars
21 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
22 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
23 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be
24 apportioned as follows:

1 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
2 the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created
3 in Section 1135.8 of this title to be used in the manner detailed in
4 the application for the special license plate;

5 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
7 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
8 and

9 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
10 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

11 E. If a person applies for a special license plate that
12 provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a
13 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by
14 the special license plate and the application shall designate a
15 specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The
16 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated
17 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated
18 funds.

19 F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
20 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
21 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
22 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
23 registered for the current year.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
3 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
4 The Tax Commission shall notify all persons issued special license
5 plates of the renewal procedures prior to the expiration of the
6 special license plate. The notice shall contain all necessary
7 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
8 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
9 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

10 If a special license plate is issued pursuant to this section,
11 any registration fee required for such plate and the fee required
12 pursuant subsection A of Section 1132 of this title shall be
13 remitted at the same time and subject to a single registration
14 period. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate rules
15 establishing a method for making required fee adjustments when a
16 special license plate is obtained during a twelve-month period for
17 which a registration fee has already been remitted pursuant to this
18 subsection. The combination of fees in a single remittance shall
19 not alter the apportionment otherwise provided for by law.

20 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
21 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
22 applications for special license plates authorized under this
23 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
24 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

1 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
2 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
3 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
4 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
5 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
6 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to the
9 effective date of this act shall not be subject to the requirements
10 and qualifications outlined in this section.

11 H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
12 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
13 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

14 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
