NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.12 of Title 70, unless 21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 Subject to the availability of funding and in addition to 23 personal financial literacy education required by the Passport to 24

Financial Literacy Act, basic life-skills education shall be taught

- 1 in the public schools of this state. Basic life skills shall
  2 include but are not limited to the following areas of instruction:
- Nutrition and cooking;
  - 2. Automobile maintenance;
  - 3. Household repairs;
- 6 4. First aid;

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- 5. Etiquette and social interaction;
  - 6. Applying and interviewing for jobs;
- 7. State and local government;
  - 8. Self-discipline and time management; and
- 9. Stress management.
  - B. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year and subject to the availability of funding, in order to graduate from a public high school accredited by the State Board of Education with a standard diploma, students shall fulfill the requirements for a basic lifeskills education.
  - C. School districts may provide instruction in basic life skills to students during grades seven through twelve. School districts shall have the option of determining when each area of instruction listed in subsection A of this section shall be presented to students.
- D. Basic life-skills instruction may be integrated into one or more existing courses of study, provided in a separate basic lifeskills course or completed through independent instruction. The

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instruction may be offered to students attending school in person,
virtually or a hybrid of both. School districts shall have the
option of determining into which course or courses each area of
instruction listed in subsection A of this section shall be
integrated.
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- E. The State Board of Education shall identify and adopt curriculum standards for basic life skills that reflect the areas of instruction listed in subsection A of this section. The standards shall be incorporated into the state academic content standards adopted by the Board pursuant to Section 11-103.6 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- F. The State Department of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
