of this section occurs on a day when school is not in session, the

moment of silence shall be observed when school is in session on the day nearest the anniversary date.

- C. The State Board of Education shall adopt a program which shall be presented on the respective anniversaries and required for students enrolled in the public schools in grades 1 through 12 that incorporates age-appropriate information about the events on April 19, 1995, and September 11, 2001, and the role these acts played in the history of the nation.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
  - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
