HOUSE BILL 3078

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Personnel Act;
modifying provisions related to overtime pay for
employees of the Department of Corrections; requiring
election; providing for codification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.9 of Title 57, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If a correctional officer accrues overtime and the overtime is
compensable, the Department of Corrections may make payment for the
overtime compensation not later than the fifteenth day of the month
if the correctional officer elects to receive the payment at that
time. A correctional officer shall be required to make an election
with regard to the timing of overtime payments which shall be
binding for a period of six (6) months at which time the election

1 may either be renewed or, if not renewed, overtime payments shall be
2 made at the same time as other payments for wages.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
