7	An Act relating to campaign finance and financial disclosure; amending 11 O.S. 2021, Sections 56-102
8	and 56-108, which relate to the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying
9	definition; amending 19 O.S. 2021, Sections 138.12, 138.13, 138.14 and 138.17, which relate to the County
10	Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying definition; removing notary requirements;
11	amending 70 O.S. 2021, Sections 2-111 and 2-117, which relate to the Technology Center District and
12	Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying definition;
13	amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 4261, which relates to the Ethics Commission Act; modifying forms necessary
14	for compliance; authorizing Ethics Commission to develop certain online reporting processes; and
15	providing an effective date.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 56-102, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	Section 56-102. A. Definitions of terms used in the Municipal
22	Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as
23	those terms are defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission
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promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma
 Constitution, unless otherwise provided herein.

3 B. As used in the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial4 Disclosure Act:

1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed
 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the
 election of a specific candidate to municipal office, whose name as
 it will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the
 committee;

2. "Municipal office" means any elective municipal office
 established under state or municipal law; and

3. "Municipal political committee" means any committee composed of <u>one two</u> or more persons whose purpose includes the election or defeat of one or more candidates for municipal office, or <u>questions</u> <u>submitted to a vote of the people at a municipal election</u>, but which is not required to register with the Ethics Commission or the Federal Election Commission.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 56-108, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 56-108. All candidates for municipal office and all 21 elected municipal officers shall be required to file a statement of 22 financial interests with the municipal clerk subject to the same 23 requirements as set forth for candidates for state office required 24 to file statements of financial interests filed with the Ethics

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Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant
 to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, including
 but not limited to time for filing and contents.

4 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2021, Section 138.12, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Section 138.12 A. Definitions of terms used in the County
7 Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as
8 those terms are defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission
9 promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma
10 Constitution, unless otherwise provided herein.

B. As used in the County Campaign Finance and Financial
Disclosure Act:

13 1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed
 14 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the
 15 election of a specific candidate to county office, whose name as it
 16 will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the committee;

17 2. "County office" means any elective county office for which
18 Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the secretary of the county
19 election board as required by Section 5-103 of Title 26 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes; and

3. "County political committee" means any committee composed of one two or more persons whose purpose includes the election or defeat of one or more candidates for county office, or questions submitted to a vote of the people at a county election, but which is

not required to register with the Ethics Commission or the Federal
 Election Commission.

3 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2021, Section 138.13, is 4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 138.13 Each campaign committee shall file a notarized statement of organization with the county election board subject to 6 7 the same requirements as set forth for candidate committees for state office to file statements of organization with the Ethics 8 9 Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant 10 to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, including 11 but not limited to time for filing and contents, except as otherwise 12 provided in the County Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure 13 Act. The statement of organization shall be accompanied by a check 14 drawn upon the campaign committee's account in the amount of Fifty 15 Dollars (\$50.00) as a nonrefundable processing fee to be deposited 16 in the County Election Board Special Depository Account. 17 Expenditures from such fees may be made by the secretary of the

18 county election board for any lawful purpose.

19SECTION 5.AMENDATORY19 O.S. 2021, Section 138.14, is20amended to read as follows:

21 Section 138.14 Every county political committee shall file a 22 notarized statement of organization with the county election board 23 subject to the same requirements as set forth for political 24 committees required to file statements of organization with the

Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated
 pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution,
 including but not limited to time for filing and contents.

4 SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2021, Section 138.17, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Section 138.17 All candidates for county office and all elected 7 county officers shall be required to file a notarized statement of 8 financial interests with the county election board subject to the 9 same requirements as set forth for statements of financial interests 10 filed with the Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics 11 Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the 12 Oklahoma Constitution.

13SECTION 7.AMENDATORY70 O.S. 2021, Section 2-111, is14amended to read as follows:

Section 2-111. A. Definitions of terms used in the Technology Center District and Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as those terms are defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, unless otherwise provided herein.

B. As used in the Technology Center District and Independent
School District Campaign Finance and Disclosure Act:

23 1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed 24 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the

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1 election of a specific candidate to school district office, whose
2 name as it will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the
3 committee;

4 2. "School district" means a technology center district or an
5 independent school district;

3. "School district office" means any elective school district
office for which Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the
secretary of the county election board as required by Section 13A105 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

10 4. "School district political committee" means any committee 11 composed of one two or more persons whose purpose includes the 12 election or defeat of one or more candidates for school district 13 office, or questions submitted to a vote of the people at a school 14 district election, but which is not required to register with the 15 Ethics Commission or the Federal Election Commission.

16SECTION 8.AMENDATORY70 O.S. 2021, Section 2-117, is17amended to read as follows:

Section 2-117. All candidates for school district office and all elected school district officers shall be required to file a statement of financial interests with the school district clerk subject to the same requirements as set forth for candidates for state office required to file statements of financial interests <u>filed</u> with the Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the

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Oklahoma Constitution, including but not limited to time for filing
 and contents.

3 SECTION 9. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 4261, is 4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 4261. The Ethics Commission shall design all forms 6 required for compliance with the County Campaign Finance and 7 Financial Disclosure Act, the Municipal Campaign Finance and 8 Financial Disclosure Act and the Technology Center District and 9 Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial 10 Disclosure Act. Such forms shall be made available in electronic form on the Commission's Internet website. Additionally, the Ethics 11 12 Commission shall develop online reporting processes for the 13 reporting of information required by the County Campaign Finance and 14 Financial Disclosure Act, the Municipal Campaign Finance and 15 Financial Disclosure Act, and the Technology Center District and 16 Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial 17 Disclosure Act, as funds are available, to develop and maintain 18 online reporting. 19 SECTION 10.
