6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; directing the  
8 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to  
9 collect justice system data; directing OMES to  
10 prepare report; authorizing OMES to promulgate  
11 necessary rules; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as 115 of 74, unless there is created a  
16 duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall be  
18 tasked with the collection of the following data from the Department  
19 of Corrections, district courts, district attorneys, public  
20 defenders, and county jail administrators:

- 21 1. The percentage of cases ending in guilty pleas;  
22 2. The percentage of people held in pretrial custody because  
23 they cannot afford bail;  
24 3. The number of dismissed cases;

- 1       4. The amount of bail in cases;
- 2       5. The average time of jail stays; and
- 3       6. The amount of times courts are utilizing alternative
- 4 sentencing.

5       B. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall take  
6 the collected data and compile it to produce a biannual report to be  
7 made accessible to the public online.

8       C. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall be  
9 granted the authority to promulgate rules necessary to carry out  
10 this act.

11       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
