13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-534.01 of Title 63, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	Any specimen collected pursuant to the newborn screening program
16	set forth in Sections 1-533 and 1-534 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
17	Statutes shall be evaluated by a laboratory and the results reported
18	to the screening hospital or physician within forty-eight (48) hours
19	of the collection of such specimen.
20	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
