18	B. The purpose of this act is to preserve the safety, health,
19	and well-being of elephants in Oklahoma.
20	C. As used in the Endangered Ark Foundation Preservation Act:
21	1. "Free contact" means the use of tools and techniques such as
22	a guide and tether to help elephants cope with certain conditions or
23	as necessary during intensive procedures associated with treating
24	chronic illnesses or animal reproduction; and

2. "Protected contact" means the contact between elephant and handler through a barrier such as a chute or an elephant restraint device.

D. It shall not be considered cruelty to animals as provided in Section 1685 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes for licensed operators of a nonprofit entity caring for elephants to practice
