17	A. The Department of Corrections shall provide minimum
18	administrative staff sufficient to ensure continuous and appropriate
19	supervision of all correctional officers at all facilities of the
20	Department according to the profile of each individual facility.
21	When establishing the administrative staff to correctional officer
22	ratio, the Department shall consider the following:
23	1. Levels of security and classifications of inmates at each
24	facility;

 facility; and
 Any other considerations that would require additional

administrative staff at each facility.
B. Beginning November 1, 2022, the Department shall be required
to have a minimum ratio of one administrative staff employee to

7 every twenty correctional officers for each facility.

8 C. The Department shall publish on the homepage of its Internet 9 website a report listing each ratio of administrative staff to 10 correctional officers for every facility of the Department.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
