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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-213 of Title 70, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. The State Department of Education shall establish a
20	microcredential program for the purpose of permitting any certified
21	teacher to complete additional coursework and earn a microcredential
22	in dyslexia.
23	B. The State Department of Education in consultation with the
24	Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability and the

Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall determine how a
 dyslexia microcredential awarded pursuant to a program established
 in subsection A of this section may be used.

C. Any course offered through a microcredential program
established pursuant to subsection A of this section may be offered
in person, online, or in a blended format of in-person and online
instruction.

D. The State Board of Education in consultation with the
Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability and the
Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, shall promulgate rules
as necessary to implement the dyslexia microcredential program and
ensure that rigor and content adequately prepares educators to
provide quality instruction.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
