6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public buildings and public works;
8 amending 61 O.S. 2021, Section 103.8, which relates
9 to the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974;
10 providing certain requirements for service contracts;
11 and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2021, Section 103.8, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 103.8 A. When a state agency accepts a services
16 contract, whether bid or no-bid, it shall list the city, state, and
17 country in which the services will be provided. Any contract the
18 state awards that is not strictly awarded by the lowest price and is
19 awarded to a company not preparing and producing the services in
20 Oklahoma shall require the awarding agency's director to provide
21 reasons why the services were not prepared and produced in Oklahoma.

22 B. When a state agency accepts any other type of contract,
23 whether bid or no-bid, it shall list the city, state and country in
24 which the company that is seeking or awarded work is headquartered.

1 If the company is an Oklahoma entity of which over fifty percent
2 (50%) is owned by an out-of-state entity or individual, then, for
3 the purposes of this section, the location of the company's
4 headquarters shall be considered to be in the city, state and
5 country of the majority owner. Any ~~work~~ contract the state awards
6 that is not strictly awarded by the lowest price and ~~that~~ is awarded
7 to a company not headquartered in Oklahoma shall require the
8 awarding agency's director to provide reasons why the out-of-state
9 company was chosen over an Oklahoma company.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
