6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; authorizing school
8 district to offer hunter safety elective course to
9 high school students; setting minimum requirements
10 for course materials and instructor; permitting State
11 Board of Education to coordinate with the Department
12 of Wildlife Conservation to promulgate rules;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. A school district may offer to students in grades nine
20 through twelve an elective course on hunter safety.

21 B. A hunter safety elective course offered pursuant to this
22 section shall be:

23 1. Based on the hunter education program offered by the
24 Department of Wildlife Conservation pursuant to Section 4-112A of
Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

1 2. Taught by an instructor who meets the qualifications
2 required by the Department for a certified hunter education
3 instructor.

4 C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the
5 Department of Wildlife Conservation to promulgate rules to implement
6 the provisions of this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
