6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to teachers; authorizing school
8 districts to require teachers to cover for absent
9 teachers during certain times; requiring district to
10 compensate the teacher a specified amount; providing
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-105.1 of Title 70, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. If, because of sickness or other reason, a teacher is
17 temporarily unable to perform regular duties, and a substitute
18 teacher is not available, the school district may require a teacher
19 who is an employee of the school district to perform the duties of
20 the absent teacher during the planning time, lunch period, or other
21 time the teacher is available to cover for the absent teacher.

22 B. The teacher who uses his or her planning time, lunch period,
23 or other available time to cover for an absent teacher shall be
24 compensated by the school district for this extra duty at a rate

1 which is determined by calculating the hourly salary of the teacher
2 and multiplying it by the number of hours the teacher covers for an
3 absent teacher each pay period.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
