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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101.42, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 6-101.42 A. For the 2022-23 school year, each school
18	district shall provide to every support employee with a salary of
19	less than Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00) per year, a three
20	percent (3%) wage increase over the base amount the employee earned
21	during the 2021-22 school year if the support employee is employed
22	by the same school district for the 2022-23 school year. The dollar
23	amount of salary increase required by this subsection shall be
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1 prorated based upon the number of total hours of work performed by a 2 full-time-equivalent support employee.

B. For the 2018-19 school year, each school district shall 3 4 provide to every support employee a wage increase over the base 5 amount the employee earned during the 2017-18 school year if the support employee is employed by the same school district for the 6 7 2018-19 school year in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,250.00). The dollar amount of salary increase 8 9 authorized by this subsection shall be prorated based upon the 10 number of total hours of work performed by a full-time-equivalent 11 support employee.

B. C. The increase increases prescribed by this section shall be in addition to any other compensation, increase in compensation, and fringe benefits provided by the district <u>or state</u>, or mandated by law or collective bargaining agreement, unless the hours or duties of the support employee are reduced proportionately.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
