HOUSE BILL 3699

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; exempting veterans from taxes on retail medical marijuana sales; authorizing Oklahoma Tax Commission to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby specifically exempted from the tax levied by Section 426 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes sales of retail medical marijuana to persons who have been honorably discharged from active service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard.

B. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall promulgate any rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
