6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to teachers; amending 70 O.S. 2021,  
8 Section 6-108, which relates to prohibition on  
9 teaching without a valid certificate; providing an  
10 exception for teachers who provide virtual  
11 instruction to secondary students; and providing an  
12 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-108, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 6-108. A. Except as provided in subsection B of this  
16 section and except for service as a director of a public  
17 developmental research school and service by a faculty member of a  
18 higher education institution affiliated with a public developmental  
19 research school as specifically authorized in this act and except as  
20 provided for in Section 6-101 of this title, it shall be unlawful  
21 for any person to serve, or to contract or agree to serve, as  
22 superintendent, elementary superintendent, principal, supervisor,  
23 librarian, school nurse, classroom teacher or other instructional,  
24 supervisory or administrative employee of a school district unless

1 the person holds a valid certificate of qualification issued in  
2 accordance with the rules of the State Board of Education to perform  
3 the services the person performs or contracts or agrees to perform.  
4 The State Board of Education shall provide for the certification of  
5 elementary superintendents.

6 B. Any person may serve, or contract, or agree to serve,  
7 without a valid certificate of qualification issued in accordance  
8 with the rules of the State Board of Education if the person is only  
9 providing virtual instruction to secondary students enrolled in a  
10 public school district.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
