19	utilized by the Department in partnership with a Federal
20	Communications Commission (FCC) licensee associated with an
21	institution of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, for
22	the purpose of establishing distance learning classrooms to deliver
23	multipronged educational resources, utilizing over-the-air
24	television broadcasts, online streaming and website accessible

1	archives delivering college credit classes, career training, and at-
2	home learning resources, with the intent of growing a statewide
3	network of public school delivery sites serving high school juniors
4	and seniors.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
