HOUSE BILL 3865

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to appropriations; making an appropriation; specifying source of funds; specifying amount; providing purpose; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) to be utilized by the Department in partnership with a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) licensee associated with an institution of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, for the purpose of establishing distance learning classrooms to deliver multipronged educational resources, utilizing over-the-air television broadcasts, online streaming and website accessible

1 archives delivering college credit classes, career training, and at-  
2 home learning resources, with the intent of growing a statewide  
3 network of public school delivery sites serving high school juniors  
4 and seniors.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
