13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.23B of Title 74, unless
14	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. An appointing authority may grant COVID-19 sick leave with
16	pay, not to exceed fifteen (15) working days per state fiscal year,
17	to a state employee who is affected by COVID-19 or a variant thereof
18	in Oklahoma after the effective date of this act if:
19	1. The employee works in a health care agency or full-time
20	custodial care facility operated by the State of Oklahoma;
21	2. The employee is required to quarantine because the employee
22	or a member of the employee's household tests positive for COVID-19
23	or a variant thereof; and

- 3. The employee has insufficient leave balances to continue in a paid leave status for the duration of the period of quarantine required by agency policy.
- B. Leave granted under this section shall be in such amounts necessary to supplement the use of the employee's paid leave after depletion of all available leave balances in order to avoid a leave without pay status.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
