16	An allopathic physician, osteopathic physician, surgeon or
17	student participating in a course of instruction, residency program,
18	or clinical training program shall not perform a pelvic examination
19	on an anesthetized or unconscious female patient unless:
20	1. The patient gives prior verbal or written informed consent
21	to the pelvic examination;
22	2. The performance of a pelvic examination is within the scope
23	of care for the surgical procedure or diagnostic examination
24	scheduled to be performed on the patient; or
