B. Student participation as provided in subsection A of this section shall be consistent with all standards and rules of the school athletic association as applied to full-time students of the resident public school, including academic progress and discipline.

A school district or resident public school shall not impose additional requirements on a virtual charter school student that are not imposed on full-time students of the resident public school.

C. Students enrolled full time in a statewide virtual charter school shall pay the same fees as other students to participate in extracurricular activities governed by a school athletic association and shall be eligible for the same fee waivers for which other students are eligible.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
