15	Section 6-211. The Beginning November 1, 2022, and every
16	November 1 thereafter, the State Board of Education in cooperation
17	with the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability, the
18	Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and institutions of
19	higher education shall conduct an educator supply-and-demand study
20	every three (3) years. The study shall identify areas of teacher
21	shortage by region, county, school districts, and academic subject
22	areas and make recommendations for addressing the areas of most
23	critical need. The Board shall submit a report <u>annually</u> outlining

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
