HOUSE BILL 4393

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-211, which relates to an educator supply-and-demand study; modifying frequency of conducting an educator supply-and-demand study; listing shortage areas to be identified in study; requiring submission of annual report; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 6-211, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-211. ~~The~~ Beginning November 1, 2022, and every  
November 1 thereafter, the State Board of Education in cooperation with the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and institutions of higher education shall conduct an educator supply-and-demand study ~~every three (3) years.~~ The study shall identify areas of teacher shortage by region, county, school districts, and academic subject areas and make recommendations for addressing the areas of most critical need. The Board shall submit a report annually outlining

1 the findings to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of  
2 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
