AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution relating to the recognition of the Day of Tears; encouraging Oklahomans to mourn lives lost to abortion in Oklahoma; directing flags to be flown at half-staff; and providing for distribution.

WHEREAS, to recognize January 22, 2022, as the Day of Tears in Oklahoma and to encourage Oklahoma citizens to lower their flags to half-staff to mourn the innocent, preborn children who have lost their lives due to abortion; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 1973, the majority of the members of the United States Supreme Court erroneously ruled that abortion was a right secured by the Constitution of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, since that ill-fated day, over sixty-one million (61,000,000) preborn children in the United States have perished.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

1 THAT the Legislature of Oklahoma does hereby recognize January
2 22, 2022, as the Day of Tears in Oklahoma and encourages Oklahoma
3 citizens to lower their flags to half-staff to mourn the innocent,
4 preborn children who have lost their lives due to abortion.
