6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution designating November 2022 as Men's  
8 Health Awareness Month.

9  
10 WHEREAS, men are one hundred percent (100%) less likely than  
11 women to pursue annual screening and preventive care; and

12 WHEREAS, nearly sixty percent (60%) of men do not regularly see  
13 a doctor; and

14 WHEREAS, men die an average of five (5) years earlier than  
15 women; and

16 WHEREAS, only seven percent (7%) of men report discussing their  
17 health; and

18 WHEREAS, higher mortality rates for men result in negative  
19 economic, social, and emotional consequences for their surviving  
20 families; and

21 WHEREAS, lack of awareness of and adherence to medical  
22 recommendations and protocols contributes to men's poor health  
23 outcomes.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT November 2022, is hereby designated Men's Health Awareness  
4 Month.
