7	A Resolution recognizing Hochatown as an important historical town and present-day tourism destination
8	in McCurtain County and the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

11	WHEREAS, Hochatown was settled in the 1830s on the banks of what
12	is today the Mountain Fork River by a group of Choctaw Indians newly
13	arrived over the Trail of Tears, one family of which was named
14	Hocha; and
15	WHEREAS, in 1894 a Post Office was established, which at its
16	peak served 175 families; and
17	WHEREAS, Hochatown is recognized as a historic community of
18	people residing in compact form continuously since the settlement
19	was established, both prior to, and after relocation to the west by
20	the United States government in order to establish Broken Bow
21	reservoir; and
22	WHEREAS, Hochatown has grown into an important tourist
23	destination, bringing in hundreds of millions of dollars to the
24	

1	region, helping to vitalize an area that once had limited economic
2	opportunities;
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4	OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
5	THAT the House of Representatives hereby recognizes the historic
6	community of Hochatown and its importance to the area and the
7	community members dedicated to improving the lives of those therein.
