22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
23	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of						
24	Human Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session

1 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Thirty-two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$32,500,000.00) shall be used for 2 providing Home and Community-Based Waiver services for persons with 3 4 developmental disabilities. These funds shall be used to provide 5 additional services and programs for persons with developmental 6 disabilities in order to eliminate the Developmental Disabilities 7 Services Division Waiting List for all people waiting as of May 1, 2022, and to implement a twenty-five percent (25%) increase in rates 8 9 for all services within the Home and Community-Based Services 10 Waivers to ensure access to services for people with developmental 11 disabilities and those served through the ADvantage Waiver. Such 12 funds shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing 13 resources and programs.

14 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 15 Human Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session 16 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five 17 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall be used to maintain 18 the funding levels from the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, of 19 Senior Nutrition programs in rural communities across Oklahoma. The 20 Oklahoma Legislature requires joint approval from the President Pro 21 Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma 22 House of Representatives before any Senior Nutrition sites may be 23 closed due to declining attendance or increased operational costs 24 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Human Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million One Thousand Eight Hundred Six Dollars (\$1,001,806.00) shall be used to fund debt service obligations for the renovation and construction of the Robert M. Greer Center located in Enid, Oklahoma.

7 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 8 Human Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session 9 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million One Hundred 10 Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000.00) shall be used for a nutrition 11 incentive program that helps low income families purchase fresh 12 fruits and vegetables.

13 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Department of 14 Human Services in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session 15 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Human Services 16 shall transfer Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars 17 (\$2,800,000.00) to the credit of the Child Abuse Multidisciplinary 18 Account established in Section 1-9-103 of Title 10A of the Oklahoma 19 Statutes, which shall be distributed according to Section 1-9-104 of 20 Title 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Human Services all federal monies received by the state during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant and the Child Care and Development Fund

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Block Grant to meet the provisions of federal law relating to such
 grants.

3 SECTION 7. The Director of the Department of Human Services may
4 request through the Director of the Office of Management and
5 Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax
6 Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the
7 purpose of early allocation to the Department's disbursing funds to
8 alleviate cash-flow problems.

9 SECTION 8. A. The Director of the Office of Management and 10 Enterprise Services shall transfer monies appropriated from the 11 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services' disbursing 12 funds in the amounts and ratios requested by the agency except that 13 the cumulative amount transferred shall not exceed the cumulative 14 amount of equal monthly allotments of the appropriations from the 15 General Revenue Fund.

16 Monies appropriated or collected for the fiscal year ending В. 17 June 30, 2023, may be transferred to these disbursing funds for the 18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to satisfy encumbrances and 19 obligations of the fiscal year; provided, that monies equal in 20 amount are transferred from appropriations or collections for the 21 fiscal year ending June 30, 2022, to the disbursing funds for the 22 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to satisfy encumbrances and 23 obligations of the fiscal year. All transfer requests shall be in 24

writing to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
 Services.

3 C. The Department of Human Services shall maintain records of4 such interyear transfers.

5 SECTION 9. The Director of Human Services may request the 6 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to 7 transfer monies between the Department of Human Services Support 8 Service Providers Grant Program Fund and the Human Services 9 Disbursing Fund or the Department of Human Services Medical and 10 Assistance Fund, as needed for the expenditure of funds.

11 SECTION 10. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 12 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not 13 including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be 14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), 15 or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 16 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only 17 through June 30, 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. 18 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for 19 FY-24, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then 20 current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered 21 only through June 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 22 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then 23 current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in 24 both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not

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1	required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted
2	for FY-24, after the agency to which the funds have been
3	appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program
4	revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and
5	after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management
6	and Enterprise Services.
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
