15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
16	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State						
17	Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not						
18	otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State						
19	Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Five						
20	Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,300,000.00) or so much						
21	thereof as may be necessary to enhance the operation of the						
22	Marijuana Enforcement Teams.						
23	SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including						
24	appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for						

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the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be
budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
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
