11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tourism and
12 Recreation Department; requiring matching funds be
13 used for certain purpose; requiring matching funds be
14 equal in amount to previous fiscal year; providing
15 for lapse of funds under certain conditions;
16 requiring certain budget procedures; and prohibiting
17 certain budget procedures.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism
20 and Recreation Department in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st
21 Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department shall make
22 available matching funds to multicounty organizations pursuant to
23 Section 2234 of Title 74 of Oklahoma Statutes. The matching funds
24 made available shall be equal in amount to the funds made available
in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

SECTION 2. Appropriations made to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23). Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
