HB 1026 allows CLEET to establish and certify additional law enforcement and criminal justice programs at state-supported technology center schools in the State of Oklahoma operating under the State Board of Career and Technology Education for teaching students between sixteen and nineteen years of age.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1026 provides that the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training may establish and certify additional law enforcement and criminal justice programs at institutions operating under the State Board of Career and Technology Education for teaching students between 16 and 19 years of age.

Upon review and with consultation from CLEET, the measure is determined to have an unknown fiscal impact. Analysis of the measure by CLEET indicated that it cannot absorb the costs to establish and certify the programs at technology centers without a mechanism to collect a fee from students enrolling in the program.
