Research Analysis

HB 1036, as introduced, allows a board of county commissioners to buy or sell materials, tools, and equipment with a political subdivision which is not subject to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act or similar competitive bidding procedure.

The measure clarifies that the county commissioners may, by resolution, buy or sell with any tribal government or county or political subdivision at a price agreed upon by both governing bodies. Further, purchasing or selling with other governments in this manner would be exempted from notice and bid requirements.
