Research Analysis

The Proposed committee substitute to HB 1044 is the omnibus license plate measure. The bill modifies the name of the Gold Star Parents license plate to the Gold Star Families license plate and allows siblings, half-siblings or grandparents to obtain the plate. The measure creates or reauthorizes the following license plates:

- Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate;
- Oklahoma Institute for Child Advocacy License Plate;
- Oklahoma Renewable Energy License Plate;
- Scottish Rite Masons License Plate;
- New State Brand License Plate;
- Tulsa Flag License Plate;
- Modifies the name of Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plate;
- Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary License Plate;
- Transportation to Transportation License Plate;
- Blue Star Mothers License Plate;
- Stillwater Public Schools License Plate;
- Oklahoma Golf License Plate;
- Historic Greenwood District Juneteenth Festival;
- Paramedic License Plate;
- National Defense Service Medal License Plate;
- Oklahoma Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary License Plate;
- University of Oklahoma RUF/NEKS License Plate;
- Tulsa Community College License Plate;

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides for clarification of certain special license plate eligibility and fund destinations, reauthorizes certain plates, eliminates certain plates and adds new plates.

No material changes are made to the fee structure related to issuance. The Tax Commission will provide complete analysis, however no measureable revenue considerations are currently anticipated.
